and soul!



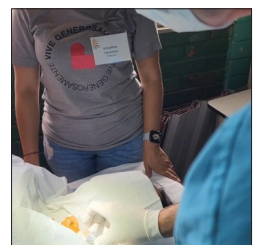
The following week we served with

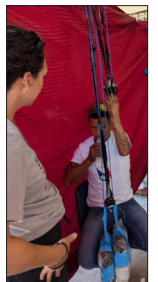

Casey, Cindy Carter, Graciela and Ruben

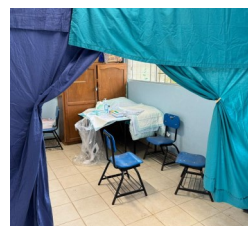
